

A NEW AUDIO-VISUAL SYSTEM IN THE CHURCH: I am very excited to see a new audio-visual system installed in our church this summer. This state-of-the art technology will vastly improve your audio and visual experience of our weekend and school liturgies and enable us to expand the use of the church for other types of worship, for formation, and for other evangelization events.

The audio system will feature top quality microphones with a dynamic array of speakers that can be adjusted to reach all parts of our church building. In addition, our tech ministry will have real-time control over all aspects of the system, allowing us to adjust volume whether the attendance is one hundred or one thousand people. We will need additional tech ministers, so if you might be interested in being trained for this important new ministry, please be in touch with Jim Wahl. We will also update our hearing assistance system and install monitors in the gathering space. Unfortunately, we are unable to sync hearing aids to the sound system via Bluetooth as this would involve tearing up the entire floor which is cost prohibitive. However, the system we currently use will be updated. You will notice during this installation that hearing in some parts of the church will be negatively impacted. We apologize in advance for this, but there is nothing we can do to prevent this from happening.

The video system in the church will utilize powerful projectors to display video and other images on large, retractable screens, approximately 15' x 9.' They can be used to display what currently appears in our worship aids, significantly reducing the waste and cost of paper. In addition, announcements and other visual elements can be shown prior to, during, and after liturgies. All of these audio and visual elements will be fully integrated with our current video streaming capabilities, allowing us to better celebrate as one community, whether present in the church or homebound. We will continue to print a limited number of worship aids to assist those who need them.

As this project unfolds, there are several adjustments we need to make in order for the company to complete the project by their deadline. They are:

- For safety reasons, the area inside the oak doors of the nave (where we celebrate
 liturgies) will be <u>closed</u> on all weekdays, Monday through Friday. Construction will
 be occurring in this area and your safety is always our top concern. This project
 will last into August, and we anticipate the nave will be closed on weekdays
 throughout this period.
- The Blessed Sacrament will not be kept in the Reservation Chapel in the church, even on the weekends. The Eucharist will remain in the weekend tabernacle located up near the sacristy for liturgies on Saturday and Sunday.
- Weekday funerals will be held in St. Mary of the Angels chapel.
- St. Mary of the Angels <u>chapel will be opened</u> for all weekday Masses, for private prayer, and for eucharistic ministers to receive the Eucharist for the homebound.
- If eucharistic ministers need to receive the Eucharist for the homebound on Saturday or Sunday, you may receive what you need from the weekend tabernacle provided you avoid doing so during weekend liturgies.
- The <u>church will be open every weekend</u>, Saturday through Sunday, for all scheduled liturgies and events.
- The parish offices will remain open as scheduled (M-F, 9am-4pm).

I look forward to experiencing the new audio-visual system sometime this fall when I am back for a visit to the parish.




